


Cutting Instructions: For a pleasing scrappy look, be sure to use several different fabrics.	
Background	<ul> <li>(2) 3 7/8" square - cut in half diagonally</li> <li>(4) 2 3/8" squares - draw a diagonal line on wrong side</li> <li>(1) 4 1/4" square</li> </ul>
Light Blue	(4) 2 3/8" square - cut in half diagonally
Med Blue	(1) 3 1/2" square
Dark Blue	<ul> <li>(1) 4 1/4" square</li> <li>(4) 2" square</li> <li>(4) 2 3/8" square - draw diagonal line on wrong side</li> </ul>

## Sewing Instructions:

Make Flying Geese (FG) using the No Waste Method by placing (1) 2 3/8" Background square in opposite corners of (1) 4 1/4" Dark Blue square, as shown. (they will slightly overlap). Sew 1/4" on each side of line. Cut apart on line, and press to Background. Next, place (1) 2 3/8" Background square in remaining corner. Sew 1/4" on each side of line. Cut apart on line, and press to Background. Your FG should measure 2" x 3 1/2"




Repeat process using (1) 4 1/4" Background square and (4) 2 3/8" Dark Blue squares.





Sew (1) of each FG together as shown:

Sew the following units together, being careful of placement:






Make 4

Your block should measure 9 1/2" Check back Jan 1st for next block.
